### 1-Distribution of window masks

On April 6, 2021, the Centre d'acquisitions gouvernementales (CAG) informed the ministère de la Famille that all verifications on window masks had been completed. The characteristics needed for verification of compliance with standard ASTM F2100 were tested by a North American ISO 17025 laboratory. These masks can now be distributed to the entire educational childcare services network.

The window masks will therefore be distributed during the week of April 19 in sufficient quantities to meet the needs of all educator staff. Also, procedure masks for non-educator staff will continue to be distributed monthly.

Deliveries will be made to the coordinating offices in each region as usual. We would like to take this opportunity to thank them for their assistance and cooperation!

Regarding the retrieval of the MC 9501 and SNN 200642 masks, the CAG is currently taking steps in this regard and we will get back to you soon with instructions.
