TO EDUCATIONAL CHILDCARE PROVIDERS

1. End of mandatory isolation for childcare staff who have received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine

In the June 18 Information Bulletin for childcare providers, we mentioned that the instructions concerning 14 days of isolation in case of contact still applied, even for persons who had received their second dose. However, the Direction générale de la Santé publique <u>announced</u> this holiday weekend an easing of the measure and an update of its guideline.

From now on, people who have received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine or have already been sick with COVID-19 in the past six months no longer have to self-isolate for two weeks after exposure to an infected individual.
