## Adjustment to certain workplace sanitary measures

Following recent government announcements, the Commission des normes, de l'équité, de la santé et de la sécurité du travail (CNESST) announced adjustments to certain workplace sanitary measures, effective as of Monday, February 28, 2022. Please refer to the CNESST [infographic](#) summarizing the relaxation of certain measures.

One of the measures relaxed concerns the wearing of a mask at all times. In fact, wearing a mask continuously is not required if two metres of distancing can be maintained. This is difficult to apply in childcare services. Nevertheless, there are some times during the day when it could work.

The Ministère de la Famille, for its part, will continue to supply protective masks.
