

Self-Assessment Grid

Sections noted during inspections and investigations

1. General Information

One of the eligibility conditions of calls for projects to create subsidized spaces is compliance with the Educational Childcare Act and its regulations. Therefore, a licensed applicant who has been served with certain targeted sections might not meet one of the eligibility conditions.

This self-assessment grid allows an applicant to check whether they are able to meet this condition. For more information on the eligibility conditions, please refer to the tools for the call for projects.

This self-assessment grid is provided for reference purposes only.

2. Instructions

To complete this self-assessment grid, you must have in your possession, where applicable, all the sections that led to any non-compliance, administrative penalties applied by the Ministère and statements of offence issued since the last full inspection or during spot-check inspections carried out in the past two years, whichever period is longer. For instance, if the last complete inspection was less than two years ago, you must take into account all spot-check inspections carried out in the past two years. The two-year reference period starts on the date of submission of the application.

- By referring to all your non-compliance notices and statements of offence, find the sections that led to violations, which are listed in the self-assessment grid;
- For each of the sections notified, check the appropriate box;
- Refer to the table below the chart to find out whether the number of findings, where applicable, results in a major reserve.

<u>Divisions 1, 2 and 3 will be considered by the Roundtable on the Allocation of Indigenous Educational Childcare Spaces for each of the shareholders and directors of the organization or enterprise submitting an application. It is therefore suggested to have each of them complete this self-assessment.</u>
